One way that we prepare students for the workplace is by having one Dress for Success day per month which also promotes and meets the Georgia Standard 1.6: "Present a professional image through appearance, behavior, and language."

Students will receive a grade of 100% for participation, which will be entered in the FBLA (10%) category. There will be four (4) Dress for Success days and one (1) makeup/bonus day. The days will be as follows:
